Guest bloggers **can** re-publish their post on their own or their company's blogs but no more than 50% of the content must not be reposted and all content must link back to HX360's original post.

TIPS:

- Word count should span 300-600 words

- Please tie your main thesis or Point-of-View back to the bulleted lists above for maximum impact

- Topics can be on case studies, news, company happenings, opinion pieces

- Write in short sentences; break up large blocks of text with bold headings and bullet your major points

- Please limit your spaces to one after each comma or period

- We recommend you submit an image with your blog posting to make your post more pleasing to the eye. If you do include an image, please provide the URL from which you copied the image so we may attribute correctly. Note: image can be your own headshot, but we'd also like an image related to your content, to support the blog post
